SECTION B

TRANSPORT PERMIT CONDITIONS: SQUID 2014

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 This permit is issued subject to the provisions and regulations of the following Laws:
 - (a) The Marine Living Resources Act, 1998 (Act No. 18 of 1998) hereafter referred to as %be MLRA";
 - (b) The National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No.107 of 1998) (%NEMA+),
 - (c) The Prevention of Pollution from Ships Act, 1986 (Act No. 2 of 1986).
- 1.2 The Director: Inshore Fisheries Management shall be entitled to amend these permit conditions.

2. SPECIFIC CONDITIONS

- 2.1 The shortest possible route must be followed from the landing point to the place of delivery as reflected on **Section A** of the permit.
- 2.2 No Squid shall be loaded or off-loaded at any point between the landing site(s) and the delivery points specified on **Section A** of the **permit**.
- 2.3 This permit/certified copy shall at all times be available for inspection by the Fishery Control Officer, Police Officer or Officer appointed by the Minister.

2.4 This Permit is valid for the transportation of Squid only.

2.5 When a squid permit holder makes use of a transport company to transport its fish, a waybill stipulating the following information must be available:

Name and address of squid catch permit holder; Squid catch permit number;

Departure point;

Destination;

Address of recipient; and

Estimated mass of squid that has been transported

The Permit Holder shall ensure that all fish is offloaded and transported in accordance with the reasonable instructions of the Fishery Control Officer/Marine Resource Monitor if the Fishery Control Officer/Marine Resource Monitor is available on site.

VALIDITY OF PERMIT

3.1

This permit shall be valid for the period indicated in Section A (% be permit+).

This permit shall automatically be invalid should the listed right holder(s) contravene the provisions of the MLRA.
