

## PROGRAM FOR THE BIODIVERSITY INVESTMENT BUSINESS TO BUSINESS (B2B) SESSION

## 1. BACKGROUND

South Africa has exceptional biodiversity, characterised by a wide variety of ecosystem types, high species richness and high levels of endemism which provides an array of benefits to the economy, society and human wellbeing. On the other hand, the Private sector is increasingly incorporating and adopting the environmental, social, and governance (ESG) factors in their business models, as result looking for investment opportunities that respond to these factors. Biodiversity sectors such as wildlife, ecotourism, bioprospecting/biotrade, marine, freshwater, forestry and biodiversity-based harvesting and production are well-positioned to attract these type of investment opportunities.

The biodiversity sector has a great potential to address the socio-economic issues specifically in rural areas of SA where this rich biodiversity is found whilst contributing to the objectives of the targets of Kunming-Montreal Global Biodiversity Framework, national policies such as the White paper on conservation and sustainable use of South Africa's biodiversity and strategies such as the National Biodiversity Economy Strategy and the National Development Plan amongst others.

## 2. PURPOSE OF THE BIODIVERSITY INVESTMENT B2B SESSION

The purpose of this session is to provide a platform for business entities, Conservation Management Authorities, PDIs, communities, who have bankable projects within the Biodiversity sector value chains to pitch their business concepts to potential investors.

## 3. OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the biodiversity investment B2B session are:

- To pitch the biodiversity economy sector as a lucrative investment portfolio for investors.
- To profile bankable opportunities within the biodiversity sector.
- To provide a platform for entrepreneurs, communities and other stakeholders to interact with investors.

## 4. Progress to date

A total of **80** projects from Conservation Agencies, PDIs, Communities were submitted to form part of B2B session. The projects are categorised as follows:

- **21** investment opportunities with National Parks, World Heritage Site, Botanical Gardens and Provincial Nature Reserves.
- 30 PDIs and community owned Wildlife based businesses.
- 18 businesses in the Bioprospecting/biotrade sector.
- 10 Ecotourism businesses.
- 1 Fisheries pipeline business opportunity

Hosting of the investment pitch
