- ➤ The **UNFCCC Code of Conduct** (CoC) applies to any event hosted or sponsored in whole or part by the UNFCCC, wherever it takes place.
- ➤ It is applicable for any event or gathering taking place on **UNFCCC premises**, whether or not it is organized, hosted or sponsored by the UNFCCC secretariat.
- ➤ The **CoC** applies to all participants at a UNFCCC event, or involved in any capacity at a UNFCCC event, including in its set up or delivery.



#### 3. Code of Conduct at the COP

- ➤ By attending or being involved in any capacity at a UNFCCC event, participants agree to abide by the CoC.
- ➤ All COP participants must sign that they will abide by the CoC at the time of registration as well as when they pick up their badges.



- > The CoC is published on the UNFCCC website
- The CoC page also includes a **learning video** on the CoC and information on how to report a complaint



- ➤ Alleged **CoC violations** at the COP can be reported through various avenues:
  - Through UNDSS officers or UNFCCC secretariat staff
  - At the Information Desk
  - Via <u>SpeakUp@unfccc.int</u>
