
Background

- Preceded by baseline CCE review conducted by Delta Environmental Centre

- South African Constitution 1996
 - Environment, social justice, human rights
- Climate Change Response White Paper 2011
 - Education/awareness, training & skills development
- White Paper on Education & Training 1995 & Curriculum & Assessment Policy (CAPS) 2011
 - Access to quality education, environment and inclusivity

Findings & Recommendations

- Convene national dialogue to define scope & focus for CCE&T in relation to CC Policy
- Develop a national CCE&T Strategy
- Recognise & advocate for trans-disciplinary skills

Establish structure & mechanism for requisite knowledge and skills

 Identify national CCE & skills development champion

Mainstream CC into education &training

 Coherent national conceptual framework for knowledge building, concept development & skills development Teacher education vary in orientation, scope & focus
