- 2. Application form must be sent to the following;



- 3. Please note: a person on any one day may collect for his or her own use or remove from the seashore 1kg shells or 50kg shellgrit without a permit. Collection or removal of more than 1kg shells or more than 50kg shellgrit on any one day for own use requires a permit from the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment.
- 4. This application must be completed and signed by the applicant. If the application is completed by a third party (such as a consultant or legal representative), the third party's details must also be provided as required in this application.
- 5. You are requested to submit your application form with all the required documentation at least 45 to 60 days prior to the date on which you intend to collect shell grit.
- 6. Please note that the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, Gazette No.38282, promulgated in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1988 (Act No. 107 of 1998), stipulate *inter alia* that "the *infilling or depositing of any material of more than 5 cubic metres into, or the dredging, excavation, removal or moving of soil, sand, shells, shell grit, pebbles or rock of more than 5 cubic metres from- (i) a watercourse; (ii) the seashore; or (iii) the littoral active zone, an estuary or a distance of 100 metres inland of the high-water mark of the sea or an estuary, whichever distance is the greater but excluding where such infilling, depositing, dredging, excavation, removal or moving (a) will occur behind a development setback; (b) is for maintenance purposes undertaken in accordance with a maintenance management plan; or (c) falls within the ambit of activity 21 in this Notice, in which case that activity applies" is a listed activity that requires environmental authorisation from the competent authority. In this case, an environmental authorisation is required from the competent authority where more than 5 cubic metres of shell grit will be collected. If no environmental authorisation is required, a confirmation letter from the competent authority need to be attached in this application form.
