Background

The inland fisheries Sector

- Remains invisible and under-valued.
- Contribution towards food security and job creation.

Recreational fishing subsector

- Estimated 1.5 million participants.
- Prominent activity on South African rivers and dams.
- Extent of the sector not fully understood.

Small-scale fishing subsector

- Present in dams and rivers.
- Range from subsistence to small-scale.
- Customary use rights not recognised.

- Policy objectives in South Africa (Poverty alleviation)
- Opportunities (food security)














Policy development process

- ☐ Training and awareness






