TRANSPORT PERMIT CONDITIONS: COMMERCIAL SEAWEED FISHERY: 2024/2025 FISHING SEASON

- 1. This permit is issued in terms of section 13 of the Marine Living Resources Act, 1998 (Act No. 18 of 1998).
- 2. The permit does not absolve the permit holder from complying with all other applicable laws, including but not limited to:
- 2.1. The National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No.107 of 1998) (NEMA), and Regulations promulgated thereunder;
- 2.2. The National Environmental Management: Biodiversity Act, 2004 (Act No. 10 of 2004) (NEMBA) and Regulations promulgated thereunder;
- 2.3. The National Environmental Management: Protected Areas Act, 2003 (Act No.
 57 of 2003) (NEMPAA) and Regulations promulgated thereunder; and
- 2.4. The National Environmental Management: Integrated Coastal Management Act, 2008 (Act No.24 of 2008) (ICM Act) and Regulations promulgated thereunder;
- 2.5. The Legal Metrology Act 2014 (Act No. 9 of 2014) and Regulations or Standards promulgated thereunder;
- 2.6. The National Regulator for Compulsory Specification Act, 2008 (Act No. 5 of 2008) as amended and Regulations or Standards promulgated thereunder;
- 2.7. The Standards Act, 2008 (Act No. 29 of 2008).
- Any reference to the Permit Holder in these Permit Conditions includes the entity or person in whose name the Permit has been issued and includes any employees (whether permanent or temporary), agents/contractors, divers or skippers of the Permit Holder.
- 4. The Permit Holder must utilise the shortest possible route by road when transporting the seaweed from the harvesting site to the processing site.

- 5. This permit does not authorise driving in the coastal area as defined in the Control of Use of Vehicles in the Coastal Area Regulations published in GNR 496 of 27 June 2014 (ORV Regulations). If the Permit Holder wishes to drive a vehicle in the coastal area, the Permit Holder must apply for a permit in terms of regulation 4(1)(a) of the ORV Regulations. - A certified copy of this permit (Section A and B) must be carried by the Permit Holder while undertaking activities authorised in this permit and must, upon request, be made available for inspection by a Fishery Control Officer (FCO) or any other authorised official.
