TRANSPORT PERMIT CONDITIONS: LARGE PELAGIC LONGLINE FISHERY

2024/2025 FISHING SEASON

- 1. This permit shall be valid for the period indicated in Section A ("the permit").
- 2. The shortest possible route must be followed from the landing point to the fish processing establishment as reflected on the permit to transport fish.
- 3. No fish shall be loaded or off-loaded at any point between the landing site(s) and the specified fish processing establishment(s).
- 4. All conditions as stipulated by the National Regulator for Compulsory Specifications (NRCS) must be strictly adhered to.
- 5. This permit shall at all times be available for inspection by the local Fishery Control Officer, Police Officer or any other Officer appointed by the Minister.
- 6. Only the following fish may be transported: tuna, swordfish, sharks ((excluding hammerheads, thresher, silky, oceanic whitetip, dusky, requiem (Carcharhinus) manta- and mobulid rays and porbeagle sharks)) billfishes and gamefish (wahoo, dorado, oilfish and other fish species reflected in the large pelagic longline catch permit).
- 7. This permit automatically expires once the validity period expires.
- 8. The Director: Offshore and High Seas Fisheries Management (D: OHSFM) shall be entitled to amend these permit conditions after consultation with the relevant stakeholders.
