INVITATION FOR STAKEHOLDERS TO SUBMIT PROPOSALS FOR CONSIDERATION DURING THE 19TH MEETING OF THE CONFERENCE OF THE PARTIES TO THE CONVENTION ON INTERNATIONAL TRADE IN ENDANGERED SPECIES OF WILD FAUNA AND FLORA (CITES)

The Conference of Parties (CoP) to the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) meets every three years to assess the implementation of the Convention through, among others, the consideration of various reports, and to make recommendations to improve the effectiveness of the Convention, as well as proposals to amend the Appendices.

In preparation for the 19th meeting of the Conference of Parties to CITES, which will be held in Panama, from 14 – 25 November 2022, the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE) hereby invites you to submit proposals for amendments to Appendix I or II or any relevant information for consideration at CoP19.

No proposals for species included in the recommendations of the High-Level Panel on the review of policies and regulations relating to elephant, lion, leopard and rhino should be submitted
