Amendment of paragraph 4

Government Notice No. 114 published in Government *Gazette* No. 41445 on 16 February 2018 is hereby amended by the substitution for paragraph (4) of the following paragraph:

"4. The timeframe for decision-making as contained in the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended, for purposes of an application for environmental authorisation or an application for an amendment of an environmental authorisation contemplated in Part 2 of Chapter 5 of the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations, 2014, as amended, contemplated in this Notice is 57 days."
