THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENT MANAGEMENT BIODIVERSITY ACT, 2004 (ACT NO.10 OF 2004)

CALL FOR NOMINATIONS OF SUITABLE PERSONS TO BE APPOINTED AS BOARD MEMBERS OF THE SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL BIODIVERSITY INSTITUTE

I, Barbara Dallas Creecy, Minister of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment, acting in terms of sections 15(1)(a) and (2)(a)(b) of the National Environment Management Biodiversity Act, 2004 (Act No.10 of 2004), hereby give notice of my intention to appoint suitable persons as Board members of the South African National Biodiversity Institute, as a result of the ending of the three-year board term of the current Board.

Members of the public are invited to submit written nominations of suitable persons to be considered for appointment. The nominations must include:

- (a) A nomination and acceptance letter of the nominee; and
- (b) Curriculum Vitae of the nominee which sets out the following:
 - (i) personal details, including full names, surname, race, gender and disability of the nominee;
 - (ii) postal and residential address, and contact number(s) of the nominee;
 - (iii) certified copies of all academic qualifications and other relevant documentation; and
 - (iv) particulars of the nominee's qualifications and experience.

The nominee must have suitable experience or expertise in any of the following fields: strategic management and leadership; community development; audit and risk; corporate governance; conservation, biodiversity management, tourism development, financial (Chartered Accountant), information technology, human resource management, or otherwise possess special insight in relation to any aspect of the activities of South African National Biodiversity Institute.

Please note that section 15 of the Act stipulates as follows:

(4) When making appointments the Minister must-

- (a) consult the MECs for Environmental Affairs; and
- (b) have regard to the need for appointing persons to promote representivity

Nominations must be submitted within 30 days of the publication of this Notice in the Government Gazette to any of the following addresses:
