The draft management plans for the two MPAs have been prepared in accordance with sections 39, 40 and 41 of the National Environmental Management: Protected Areas Act, 2003 (Act No. 57 of 2003). The management plans do not give or take away rights in the MPAs. The management plans are an important tool for the collective management of the MPAs and are a key planning tool for the current and future management of MPAs.

The draft MPA management plans are available for public comment for a period of **thirty (30) days** after the publication of this notice in the newspaper. Any comments received after the specified timeframe may be disregarded.
