FISHING RIGHTS ALLOCATION PROCESS (FRAP) RECEIPTING OF APPLICATIONS

Applicants must deliver their completed applications for fishing rights in the KZN Prawn Trawl, Demersal Shark, Squid, Tuna Pole, Hake Handline, White Mussel, Oyster and Traditional Linefish fishing sectors to one of the following venues during the dates and times stipulated in the table below. Applications may not be faxed, posted or emailed.

Applicants must submit one original and one copy of the application form and annexures. The application, duly signed and attested, must be punched and placed into a lever arch file with a divider before each annexure. The annexures must be numbered according to the schedules.

The copy must be a true copy of the original and must be punched, divided and filed in the same manner as the original.

See "Important Information" in the application forms for more instructions on the completion and lodgement of applications.

Co-ops, close corporations and companies that could not register their legal entities in time and that would not have registration documents when they have to submit their applications must just submit proof that they have applied to have their legal entities registered.
