THE DEPARTMENT TO CONDUCT A CATCH-ALL WEEK FOR WESTERN CAPE SMALL-SCALE FISHERIES VERIFICATION AND REGISTRATION PROCESS

The Department of Forestry, Fisheries, and the Environment distributed verification forms from 26 September 2022 to 07 October 2022 in 68 venues covering 109 fishing communities targeting over 8000 individuals in the Western Cape. The process, as guided by the Court Order of the 31 August 2022, was only open to those community members that participated in the initial Small-Scale Fisheries process in 2016.

The department received an exceptional response during the two weeks of distribution of verification forms as those who were eligible to receive verification forms went out in numbers. The department further noted that there were a number of individuals who could not attend the distribution process due to compelling reasons, and made plans, through proxies, for the forms to be received by their proxies as was advised by the department.

Based on the analysis, there are areas where the department managed to get up to 96% of people who collected their forms. However, there are also areas where the department reached out to as little as 42%. For week one, the department managed to reach a total of 59.88% participants and in week two, the department managed to reach a total of 75.9% participants. In total, 67% of verification forms were issued to previous participants during the two weeks of distribution.

In order to show fairness and provide further access to the process, the department is planning to have a catch-all week from 17 October 2022 to 21 October 2022. The department will set up in central venues in each region, as displayed below. This is where those who might have not collected their forms can be able to collect their forms between 9h00 and 16h00, on the specified dates.

If an eligible community member is unable to collect his/her verification form as per the below schedule for valid reasons (e.g., medical emergency, death of an immediate family member), they are to complete a proxy letter that is obtainable at their nearest department al Fisheries Compliance Offices, or via email at SSFMProxy@dffe.gov.za, in order for an authorised person to receive a verification form on behalf of an eligible person.

Please note: "fishing" or "attending to other business" will not be regarded as valid reasons for not making it to the meetings to receive a verification form.

Notes on Verification Process

- Verification forms are not for sale.
- Each verification form will have a unique sequence number and the form should not be photocopied,
- Eligible community members will be required to visit the distribution centres to collect their verification forms, If a community member knows that they participated in 2016, but does not appear on the lists, they will be required to provide proof that shows they participated in the initial process in 2016.

The Catch-All Process Timeline will be as follows:
