
What (a) total number of registered professional hunters in the Republic are previously disadvantaged individuals and (b) percentage of the total number of registered professional hunters does this constitute?

1745. THE MINISTER OF FORESTRY, FISHERIES AND THE ENVIRONMENT REPLIES:

- (a) Noting that this information may keep changing during a particular year. From the unaudited information gathered to date, there are approximately 101 registered professional hunters categorised as previously disadvantaged individuals (PDIs).

(b) The 101 PDIs registered professional hunters constitute approximately 4% of the total figure of 2786 registered professional hunters in South Africa.
