Mr M M Chabangu (Free State: EFF) to ask the Minister of Environmental Affairs:

In respect of the number of contraventions on the conditions for Environmental Authorisation by the SA

National Road Agency Limited (Sanral) (details furnished), (a) why has there been a lack of compliance

and (b) what action is being taken to hold Sanral accountable in this regard?

278. THE MINISTER OF ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS REPLIES:

(a)

At this stage it is unclear why there has been non-compliance to certain conditions of the environmental

authorisation. The representations which South African National Road Agency (SANRAL) is allowed to

submit in response to the pre-compliance notice recently issued should provide an indication on the

reasons for the lack of compliance.

(b)

The non-compliances by SANRAL were initially investigated by the Compliance team in the Department

and the matter was then referred to the Enforcement Chief Directorate to take enforcement action. An

enforcement notice as contemplated in section 31L of the National Environmental Management Act has

been prepared and recently issued to SANRAL. In order to undertake this process the Department

must comply with the provisions of the Promotion of Administrative Justice Act ("PAJA") as well as

subregulation 8(2) of the Environmental Management Inspectorate (EMI) Regulations by providing

SANRAL with an opportunity to make representations in response to the allegations of non-compliance

as well as the intended instructions, prior to moving forward with further enforcement action. The

decision as to whether, and also what type of final enforcement action will be taken, is dependent on

various factors such as the submissions that are made by SANRAL in response to the enforcement

notice and whether or not the areas of non-compliance have been addressed.
