With regard to the international funding received by her department for climate change interventions, (a) what projects have been implemented by her department and (b) in which provinces; and (c) what are the relevant details of each project?

3354. THE MINISTER OF FORESTRY, FISHERIES AND THE ENVIRONMENT REPLIES:

(a)(b)(c)

The Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment is currently implementing a project titled “**Cities Adapt: Strengthening Climate Change Adaptation in Cities**” in the City of Umhlatuze within KwaZulu-Natal province in partnership with Deutsche Gesellschaft für Internationale Zusammenarbeit (GIZ) on behalf of the Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ). The project's objective is to build and improve resilience to climate change impacts in selected cities and disadvantaged urban neighbourhoods in Mexico and South Africa. GIZ as an Implementing Entity for the BMZ also provides funding support through their Climate Support Programme (CSP4).

The following projects/programmes are being implemented:

- **Sector Support Programme:**
 - ✓ **Human Settlements:** Development of Climate Risk Profiles and Climate Action Plans in 22 Priority Human Settlement and Housing Development Areas (PHSDHAs) located in Mpumalanga, Limpopo, KwaZulu-Natal.
 - ✓ **Health:** Development of Climate Change Adaptation Strategy for the Health Sector.
 - ✓ **Oceans and Coast:** Development of Ocean and Coast Adaptation Plan for four coastal provinces, i.e. Eastern Cape, KwaZulu-Natal, Northern Cape and Western Cape.

- **Cities Resilience Programme:**

Development of Climate Risk Profiles and Action Plans for the City of Mbombela in Mpumalanga and the City of Polokwane in Limpopo provinces.

- **Provincial Support Programme:**

Funding Support with an estimated value of **74335 USD** received from the International Institute for Sustainable Development (IISD) and NAP Global Network to review Provincial Climate Change Adaptation Strategies for Free State and Mpumalanga provinces.

- **Local Government Support Programme Phase 6: (LGCCSP 6)**

Support includes capacity building, mainstreaming on climate finance and the development of project proposals in Free State, Northern Cape, KwaZulu-Natal and Eastern Cape provinces.

The resources are dedicated to the actual deliverables, and service providers are contracted directly with GIZ as the Implementing Entity/Agency.
