(a) How many vacancies currently exist in her department, (b) in which (i) categories and (ii) levels are

such vacancies and (c) for how long has each specified position been vacant in each case?

835. THE MINISTER OF FORESTRY, FISHERIES AND THE ENVIRONMENT REPLIES:

(a) The Department has a total of 568 vacant posts, of which 204 have been prioritised for filling and

are currently on different Recruitment and Selection phases. 23 of these posts have already

been filled. Because of constraints on the compensation of employees budget, the Department is

only advertising urgent, critical and essential service vacancies in line with the DPSA Circular 19

of 2020. Please see Annexure A.
