- (1) Whether her Department will offer any form of Covid-19 financial and/or other relief to small businesses; if not, why not; if so, what are the relevant details; and
- (2) whether the Covid-19 financial and/or other relief will only be allocated to qualifying small businesses according to the Broad-Based Black Economic Empowerment Act, 2003 (Act No. 53 of 2003), as amended; if not, what is the position in this regard; if so, (a) on what statutory grounds and/or provisions does she or her Department rely to allocate Covid-19 financial or other relief only to small businesses according to the specified Act, and (b) what form of Covid-19 financial or other relief, if any, will be made available to other small businesses?
