SCIENTIFIC OUTPUT OF THE BRANCH: FISHERIES MANAGEMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF

AGRICULTURE, FORESTRY AND FISHERIES (during the course of 2019 the Branch became part of the Department of Environment, Forestry and Fisheries)

This document lists the scientific output of the Fisheries Management Branch for 2019, arranged by output category. Figures in brackets represent the output for the previous two years, 2018 and 2017, respectively, and are included for comparison. In the category 'peer-reviewed publications' there were 41 (30, 35) papers, an increase compared with the previous two years. There was an increase to 12 (9, 3) documents in the category 'theses/dissertations/tertiary projects', none of which were DAFF-authored but all of which were DAFF-supervised or co-supervised. There were 50 (11, 7) documents in the category 'book chapters, published reports and popular articles'. This substantial increase over previous years was attributable primarily to two major categories of published report, The IUCN Red List of Threatened Species (27 contributions) and the South African National Biodiversity Assessment 2018, published by the South African National Biodiversity Institute (16 contributions). There were 40 (27, 80) 'contributions to symposia and conferences, and public presentations', 12 of which were presentations at the 5th Southern African Marine Linefish Symposium, 6 at the 5th Southern African Shark and Ray Symposium, 4 at the 11th WIOMSA Scientific Symposium, and 3 at the Southern African Society of Aquatic Scientists Congress, all of which were symposia with broad relevance to the research area of the Branch. There were 64 (53, 30) 'contributions to workshops, short courses, and management and scientific bodies, and unpublished technical reports'. Of these, 15 were contributions to meetings of regional fisheries management organisations, the Indian Ocean Tuna Commission (IOTC) (7), the International Commission for the Conservation of Atlantic Tunas (ICCAT) (5) and the Commission for the Conservation of Southern Bluefin Tuna (CCSBT) (3). In addition, there were 12 contributions to meetings of the Convention for the Conservation of Antarctic Marine Living Resources (CCAMLR), 8 contributions to the DAFF/MARAM International Fisheries Stock Assessment Review Workshop and 7 contributions to the AFriMagua Workshop. Finally, there were 59 (68, 51) unpublished working group documents. This last category represents the output of the research component of the Branch in terms of its line function to provide scientific advice for resource management.
